

Dear Parents,

Phased re-opening of schools.

Schools have been made aware that the most recent reproduction (R) median value for the North West is reported as being 1.01.

The Secretary of State has stated that, as one of the 5 tests, the R value should be below 1 before it would be safe for schools to open for more children.

Governors have agreed that, given the above, and in line with the most recent guidance from Liverpool Local Authority, the school **will not be reopening for children in Year 6 on Monday 15th June.**

Schools expect to receive advice from Public Health England and Liverpool Local Authority over the next weeks which will inform the decision as to when the school can safely open for additional children.

We will remain open for keyworker and vulnerable children.

Please do not allow those in the mainstream media, or even your own social media, to create anxiety and unrest around children falling behind at this time. We are in the midst of a global pandemic and the priority is staying safe as a family.

Your children are precious and mean the world to us so for that reason, we will only open the school up to other year groups when it is completely safe to do so.
