

Self-isolation and Bubble isolation

Google Classroom

During each day of self-isolation period, work will be posted to the Google Classroom. This will be content from the government approved Oak National Academy. As closely as possible, work posted will match curriculum content taking place in school.

For example, if pupils are studying Letter Writing in English at school, your child will get an Oak National Academy Unit on Letter Writing, which will last the length of the isolation period. We would then do the same for other subjects, matching them with the school's curriculum.

Handing in work

Some parents have attempted to upload children's work and have experienced difficulties in doing so. Although it is possible to upload work, we do not expect parents to do this. Instead, once pupils have completed their learning (including the quiz which provides instant feedback) they can click 'Hand in' on the Google Classroom.

Doodle

Your child will now be accustomed to using the four Doodle apps (English, Spelling, Tables and Maths). These apps can be used regularly throughout the isolation period, giving pupils a personalised curriculum and independent activity time.

Maths No Problem

Pupils can access the textbook and workbooks as explained in previous correspondence. With Parents, pupils can review prior learning and look at lessons matching their current learning.

Expectations of pupils during isolation period:

- Pupils must complete all lessons posted and must check daily
- Pupils must use the Doodle Apps regularly
- Pupils can review Maths No Problem with parents and revisit previous learning
- Reading for pleasure – it is important that pupils enjoy reading and read widely every day
- Access other apps such as TT Rockstars
