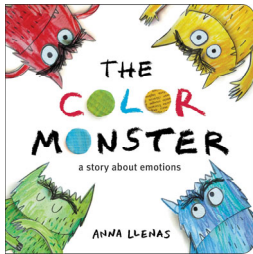




# Reception Home Learning Activities
