We are reading:



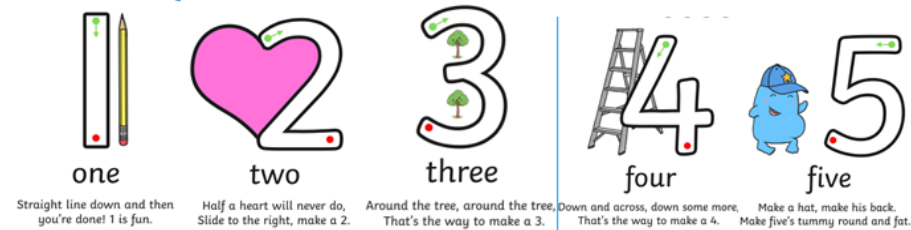
This week we will be celebrating 'World Nursery Rhyme Week' in class. As well as enjoying some well known classics, we will also be looking closely at rhyming words.

These little rhymes may help you to practise writing the numbers to 5 at home.



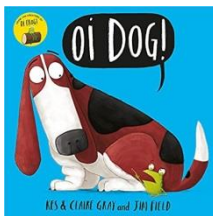
Keep it fun – writing numbers into shaving foam in the bath, using straws/sticks to make numbers.
