COMMENTS

- My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school: Most are same day after school and clashes with swimming. We try and organise after school clubs on all days and rotate them across different year groups each term. In the event of over subscription we also hold a waiting list and the children on this are given priority when the club runs again. This term: Monday Dance & Art & Craft; Tuesday: Choir; Wednesday: Futsal & Drama; Thursday: BEAP; Friday: Boxercise & Drama. Hopefully the rotation will mean your child can access a club at some point.
- **Limited After School & PE opportunities**: As we have no field and accommodate an After School Club on site each evening, we are limited as to what we can offer after school.
- It's a real shame that swimming lessons weren't replaced: We agree, but when the baths re-opened after being closed for a term, our timetabled afternoon slot had been replaced with a morning slot which could not be accommodated in either our timetable or staffing structure. Year 5 children will be swimming at a new venue in the summer term.
- Parents' Evening slot should be longer: Parents are welcome to discuss any problems with teachers at any time and don't need to wait for Parents' Evening.
- More opportunities for parental involvement: This term the school has held Welcome to Year Group
 Meetings, a welcome to Reception BBQ, a Y2 Maths Meeting, a Reception Reading and Writing meeting, the
 Home School Association AGM and the Parish Sacramental preparation meetings. Staff have attended special
 Masses for different year groups and Parish meetings with parents. Any suggestions as to what could be done
 to further involve/work with parents is welcomed.
- Opportunities for more able pupils to be advanced further down the school, especially in English: I am not
 exactly sure what this is a request for but please come and speak to me with respect to any ideas you may
 have.
- First concern raised recently- not yet dealt with: I hope the member of staff this was raised with has responded. Please let me know if this is not the case and we can arrange a meeting.
